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* Could use group captains: Sr. High could have two group captains and adult class could have four.

- ❖ *What is a "group captain"? A group captain is simply a Sunday School teacher who doesn't teach.*
- ❖ *We never want to maintain, we want to always position ourselves for growth!*

** It is suggested that you think of a catchy name for this class, "Golden Oldies," etc...

Notes:

- 1) Notice this structure is still a natural splitting and expansion of Charts "1-A" and "2-B".
- 2) Growth by division is still in process.
- 3) When restructuring an existing Sunday School, begin with this approach.
- 4) Remember to design/build for the present function of each "space" and your future vision.
- 5) Do not be too rigid and dictating in the adult groupings. Leave freedom for attendees to choose by teacher, age group, and desire. Remember, the goal is relationship and attitude – "KEEPING."
- 6) The potential: Using Division Directors as teachers and discounting the possibility of group captains, there are 19 teachers with 10 pupils each, equaling an attendance of 190. With group captains and successful divisions, 6 more teachers (with 10 pupils each) would be added, giving an opportunity for 250 in S. S. attendance.
