Thank you for your ministry in prayer for the two OGI Institutes in Columbia. This was our first training ministry in this beautiful country. We were in two different cities about 400 miles apart. The report and pictures are below. Both events were a great success thanks to the Lord and your prayers.

Speaking of prayer, allow me to share two **urgent requests**:

- I will be holding a OGI Institute in Villa del Salvador, Peru this month, leaving on the 18th and returning the 25th. Again, we will have pastors and leaders coming in from all over Peru with an anticipated 100. As always, my greatest desire is to be of help to these dear men who come at great sacrifice and with such desire to receive something that will help them in their ministry for the Lord. I am keenly aware of that and also of the fact that without the help and presence of our dear Lord that need will not be met. My prayer request is akin to that of Paul writing to the church at Ephesus "...that utterance may be given unto me..."
- This month marks 15 years since I resigned my pastorate of 33 years and officially began my ministry as director of the Hispanic Division of OGI. From a "zero ministry-presence" in 2010 to now having partners in every Spanish-speaking country in Latin America except Venezuela and Puerto Rico, I am humbled at what God has and continues to do. As I have shared in person and letter in the past, one of the pressing needs is for God to provide a "Timothy" that I can begin training to share in this growing ministry and assure its future stability and continuance for God's glory. At my age (80 years) every day is a special gift. I want to be a good steward of what God has entrusted to me in this ministry. Long story short, there may be such a man we are considering who could be God's man for this need. However, the great need will be the monthly support for he and his family that must be raised. Please join with me in earnest and fervent prayer about this. The local church and its people have always been the lifeline that God has provided.
