### 2025 Operation Go International Partners Gathering Recap

Theme: "Making A Difference"

This year's annual Partner's Gathering was one of the most impactful we have ever experienced! Attendance was noticeably greater than last year, and from the opening session to the closing challenge, the spirit of the meeting was electric with God's presence and a shared passion to make a real difference in the nations.

Throughout the gathering, our field directors brought updates that left hearts stirred, tears flowing, and attendees deeply moved to pray, give, and go. Many told us, "I've never felt more challenged to step into God's global mission!" Another partner shared, "Hearing what God is doing across continents gave me fresh excitement to stay involved—lives are being changed eternally, and I get to be a part of that story."

#### Partner Highlight Testimony – Testimony from a first-time attendee

"I came to the Gathering expecting to hear good reports... but I left completely changed. As I listened to the stories of pastors being trained and churches springing up across Latin America, Africa, and Asia, I realized I couldn't stand on the sidelines any longer. God spoke to my heart during the closing challenge—this is the time to pray more, give more, and do more for the nations. What a joy to know that my small part is having a big eternal impact! This year, I'm stepping out in faith to do more than ever before."



The work of God in Latin America continues to grow at an exciting pace, as Bro. James Adams shared during our recent gathering. Truly, lives are being transformed as pastors are equipped, churches are being planted, and multitudes are coming to know Christ.

#### In the past year alone, by God's grace:

- 11 conferences were held across 9 different countries,
- Over 650 pastors were trained and equipped,
- More than 420 new churches were planted, and
- Thousands of lives were transformed by the Gospel as men, women, and families came to salvation.

These numbers represent more than statistics—they tell the story of countless individuals and communities being renewed by the power of Christ.

# To sustain this momentum and continue advancing the work, we are trusting God to provide \$70,000 this year. These funds will enable us to:

- Continue hosting regional conferences,
- Train and mentor pastors who are hungry for truth,
- Provide resources for new church plants, and

## **EAST AFRICA** — HOPE RISING — Bro. Peter Chege



A highlight of the conference was hearing from our East Africa Director, Bro. Peter Chege, as he shared how God is moving powerfully across Kenya and surrounding nations. Truly, 'hope is rising' in this region!

#### Flourishing Ministry in Kenya and Beyond

- Our Training Center is raising up leaders—and its long-awaited expansion is nearly complete, needing only \$25,000 more to finish.
- The Orphanage is providing Christ-centered care, food, and education for nearly 300 children, giving them stability, hope, and a future.
- A vibrant Widow's Ministry is meeting both physical and spiritual needs among some of the most vulnerable in society.
- Technical Training Programs are equipping young people with practical skills alongside a strong Biblical foundation.
- New Church Plants are spreading the Gospel in unreached communities, multiplying the light of Christ across Kenya and East Africa.

Every week, we hear from national pastors across East Africa, asking for Biblical training, mentoring, and resources to reach their countries with the Gospel. With God's help, we are poised to hold over 25 different training conferences across East Africa next year. These sessions would give us the opportunity to train thousands of pastors and leaders for less than \$50,000 total! The harvest truly is plentiful!

Our "Hope for the Hungry" project remains one of the most urgent needs. For less than five cents a meal, we can feed families facing hunger and famine while also sharing with them the eternal hope of the Gospel. Through this effort, our vision is to feed over 5 million people across East Africa—physical food paired with the Bread of Life.

We are thrilled to share that a generous donor has pledged a \$100,000 matching gift to be met by the end of this year! Every dollar given will be doubled—multiplying your impact to expand the training center, feed the hungry, and equip churches across East Africa.

Together, we believe we can see a great harvest across East Africa—hope rising in Christ for millions.

# **MIDDLE EAST** -- Light in the Darkness — Bro. Gary Wilkins

















This year's gathering was marked by both brokenness and hope as Bro. Gary Wilkins shared the incredible ways God is moving in one of the hardest-to-reach regions of the world—the Middle East. Truly, the Gospel is shining as a light in the darkness.

With great joy, we celebrated our first-ever conference in Cairo, Egypt. This was a landmark moment—bringing together believers and leaders hungry for truth, fellowship, and encouragement in a place where the Gospel witness is so greatly needed. The response was powerful, confirming a desire for deeper discipleship and equipping across the region.

In addition, Bro. Wilkins shared the launch of the 'Mercy Project', a new initiative to deliver hope and tangible relief to some of the most vulnerable:

- Children affected by poverty and war,
- Refugees uprooted from their homes and communities, and
- Victims of slavery in places like Pakistan and Syria.

The need is urgent, and our initial goal of \$75,000 will enable us to begin offering food, shelter, medical help, and Gospelcentered restoration to some of the most oppressed people in the Middle East.

Requests are pouring in from national pastors all throughout the Middle East, pleading for Biblical training, encouragement, and partnership in ministry. In a time and place dominated by oppression and religious control, there is an unmistakable openness to the truth and love of Christ. Many are weary of violence and hatred, and are longing for grace, peace, and the good news of the Gospel.

As Bro. Wilkins reminded us, in the darkest places the light of Christ shines brightest.

# INDIA — Pathways to Change -- Bro. Thomas Maher

We are rejoicing with him in all that the Lord is doing in India through the work of OGI! The Gospel continues to bring transformation, and we are humbled to see lives changed in extraordinary ways. Through the faithful labor of our partners and leaders in India, we are witnessing:

- Souls saved and lives changed for eternity.
- Thousands of national pastors trained and equipped for ministry.
- Thousands of new churches planted, bringing the Gospel into both villages and cities.
- Many thousands of individuals and families fed, clothed, and cared for —with the message of Christ's love shared alongside meeting physical needs.

Our established ministries in southern India are thriving by God's grace:

- Training Center & College raising up pastors and leaders for the harvest field.
- Church & School reaching the community with both spiritual and educational growth.
- Orphanage providing hope, stability, and care to children who need a safe home and the love of Christ.

One of the most exciting opportunities presented this year has been the "India Child Care Project." For just \$45 a month, a child is given: clothing, nutritious food, education, and opens the door for children to grow in the knowledge and hope of Christ.

## ZAMBIA -- A Gateway for Southern Africa — Bro. Bryan Treadway

Zambia has the potential to become a strategic hub for OGI in southern Africa. From this location, we envision a training center that will:

- Equip pastors and leaders to plant and grow churches.
- Serve as a base for humanitarian outreach—distributing food, clothing, and clean water to those in need.
- Care for orphans and vulnerable children.
- Support efforts to dig wells for villages without safe drinking water.

From October 6-10, Brother Bryan will be meeting with the Council of Chiefs and Government Leaders in Zambia. The purpose of these meetings is to present the ministry vision, outline our plans, and, Lord willing, secure permission and access to purchase land in the Livingstone area.

We are prayerfully considering a 15-acre property that would provide the space we need to establish this vital center and allow room for future growth.

We praise God for a matching grant of \$65,000, generously offered by a faithful donor. Every dollar given toward this matching gift will be doubled, helping us reach the goal to purchase land and move forward with this kingdom-expanding vision.

Together, we believe Zambia can become a "light for the nations," a place of equipping, compassion, and transformation for years to come.

We are overwhelmed to share OGI's worldwide reach this past year:

- 20,000+ pastors trained
- 19,000 churches planted across 103 countries
- 75,000+ Bibles distributed
- 1.5 million souls professing faith in Christ!

## Spiritual Challenge & Response

Although Dr. Gibbs was unable to join us due to illness, God provided in a powerful way through Brother R. B. Ouellette, who closed the gathering with a stirring message from Matthew 9:35–38. His challenge to "pray for laborers" and personally be involved left many deeply moved. Several attendees testified, "God spoke directly to me to step out in faith and give sacrificially." Others said, "I am committed to praying more diligently for the nations from this day forward."



## Faith Goals for 2025

We are stepping forward in faith with these goals from the Gathering:

- An immediate offering of \$100,000 resulting from this meeting
- \$250,000 committed over the next year to sustain and expand the work

The testimony of this year's Gathering is simple yet profound:

God uses ordinary people to make an extraordinary difference when we surrender to His call.

As we reflect on this special gathering, we are filled with gratitude for each one of you—our partners and friends.
