My Dear Friend, November 1, 2025

As the leaves turn and the air cools, the Gospel warms our hearts with a season-long reminder: Thanksgiving isn't a holiday on a calendar; it's a posture at the foot of the Cross. The good news that Jesus died, was buried, and rose again compels us to say, "Thanks be unto God for his unspeakable gift" (2 Corinthians 9:15). In a world that often measures life by scarcity, the Gospel teaches us to measure by grace. This fall, may gratitude be our Christian accent; heard in our prayers, seen in our generosity, and felt in our love for neighbors near and far.

As the calendar turns toward Thanksgiving, I am reminded that gratitude is more than a date—it's a decision. The holiday gathers us around tables, but the devotion of our hearts gathers us around Christ, who is the Giver behind every good gift. This month we'll lean into a simple, life-shaping theme: being thankful on purpose. Not a reaction to perfect circumstances, but a daily choice to notice God's hand, name His mercies, and nurture a grateful posture in every season. As we celebrate with family and friends, may we allow thanksgiving to steady our soul, soften our words, and strengthen our service. Let's not wait for gratitude to find us; by God's grace, let's pursue it—purposefully, prayerfully, and joyfully.

Gratitude is not naïve denial; it's faith's decision. It looks beyond what is missing to the Master who is present. Here are three ways to practice being thankful on purpose:

Survey God's Sovereignty

"O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good" (Psalm 136:1). Thanksgiving begins by looking up before we look around. When we survey who God is—wise, good, unchanging—we remember that no event outruns His control or outgrows His care. Gratitude steadies the soul because it knows history and history bows to His hand.

Savor God's Salvation

"Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits" (Psalm 103:2). We savor salvation by rehearsing the Gospel daily: forgiven sins, a new heart, a family in Christ, and a future hope. If God never gave us another earthly blessing, Calvary has already given us more than we could deserve in a thousand lifetimes.

Scatter God's Supply

"Freely ye have received, freely give" (Matthew 10:8). Gratitude doesn't hoard; it scatters. The thankful heart becomes open hands—sharing time, testimony, and treasure. The miracle of thanksgiving is that givers discover they are always living in the overflow.

Gratitude is not a reaction to circumstances; it's allegiance to Christ.

ZAMBIA FIELD UPDATE -- A Door Opened Wide

I've just returned from Zambia overflowing with gratitude. Over two Sundays, I preached in two different churches and watched God move—souls were saved, believers were strengthened, and lives were visibly changed at the altar. Alongside these Gospel victories, two chiefs formally committed to partner with OGI, each expressing willingness to grant land for ministry development—an unmistakable answer to prayer. God also knit together the right team. He brought us a sharp, servant-hearted young man who's already trained in the very areas we need—administration, field logistics, and agriculture/training support—so we can move forward in Zambia with competence and credibility. In addition, the Lord opened the door to a seasoned, Christian consultant in Lusaka whose connections within government and practical know-how are exactly what we need to navigate registration, compliance, and land ownership.

We're working diligently to establish OGI in full alignment with local requirements. Lord willing, I'll return in December to visit both regions, select specific parcels, and advance the paperwork for legal establishment and land acquisition. Please keep praying for continued favor, clarity, and the right local partners as we take these crucial steps.



We're grateful to report that our Latin American Director, James Adams, ministered in Chile where attendance averaged around 160 at the conference. Many pastors and leaders were encouraged and helped, and doors for future training opened. This trip was especially moving because it was Bro. James's first journey since nearly dying in the Spring. We praise God for sparing his life and restoring his strength. Please keep Bro. Adams, his family, and the pastors he served in your prayers.
