My Dear Friend,

January 1, 2025

I pray you had a wonderful Christmas season, and that God blessed you greatly and abundantly. As we embark on a new year, I'm always amazed at how quickly the season ends and life starts at a full pace again. The poem by Dave Veerman, "Many Happy Returns," captures the aftermath of Christmas:

'Twas the day after Christmas, and all through the room, strewn wrappings were crying for use of a broom. The children were scattered, the friends' gifts exploring, since now most of theirs, were broken or boring. All tummies were stuffed, from the fabulous feast. Leftovers would serve, for one month at least. And mama and papa were countryside ranging, those unwanted gifts, returned or exchanging. Yes, Christmas is past, with its bustle and noise, sales and carols, Santas and toys. Decorations are packed, The Yule trees discarded. The holiday's over, just as we got started!

Now that Christmas has crescendoed, some of us are back to our complicated and chaotic lives. Others of us have moved from "ho, ho, ho" to humdrum. Has your "fa-la-la-la" turned to blah-blah-blah?

Like Joseph and Mary, we may have experienced a letdown. Initially, they were joyfully greeted by shepherds, then later, wise men from the East arrived, worshipped the Christ child, and brought expensive gifts. However, things took a negative turn, as depicted in Matthew's narrative, which is filled with sadness, fear, pain, problems, blood, and lament. This bleak picture is often omitted from Christmas cards and carols. Let's look now at three ways to beat the blahs.

1. Exhibit Instant Obedience. Though Joseph never spoke, his actions spoke volumes. When instructed, he obeyed immediately. For instance, when the angel told him to marry Mary in Matthew 1:24, he woke up and took her home. Similarly, when the angel instructed him to flee to Egypt, he left while it was still dark. Notice Joseph's lack of questions, requests, or complaints. Once the Lord spoke, he accepted it without hesitation.

Where is the Lord expecting immediate obedience? Is there a prompt He's given you that you've delayed? Is there a decision you've been putting off? An ungodly relationship to sever? An application to send in? A gift to give? A commitment to make? A person to forgive? Or deciding to plug into OGI like never before?

2. Expect Constant Opposition. If we call ourselves followers of Christ, we'll experience opposition and persecution, just as Jesus and his family did. We want a sentimental Christmas, but that's not possible. Properly understood, Christmas should challenge us. This post-Christmas world isn't our hope or home. Just as Joseph endured opposition for the baby, we should expect no less. God led him through the difficulties, and He will lead you through whatever you may face this year.

3. Embrace God's Operation. The real work of Christmas begins when the angels' song is stilled, the star is gone, kings and princes return home, and shepherds return with their flocks. God weaves history to accomplish His will, and nothing surprises or slows Him because He rules and reigns. Though we may not understand, we can simply obey and trust God. Interestingly, God didn't tell Joseph to go to Nazareth until he obeyed and went to Judea. The old adage is true: "God doesn't steer parked cars." To be guided, start moving on what you already know He wants you to do.

I opened with a poem called "Many Happy Returns" but never finished it. I conclude with it now:

To celebrate peace, and the meaning of giving. To discover real love, and the purpose for living. Dear Jesus, please help us to stop and remember; that you came to earth, not just for December. But from birth in a manger to death on a cross, You gave up glory, and counted it loss.

So now as we trust You - God's only Son - The real celebration, Has only begun!

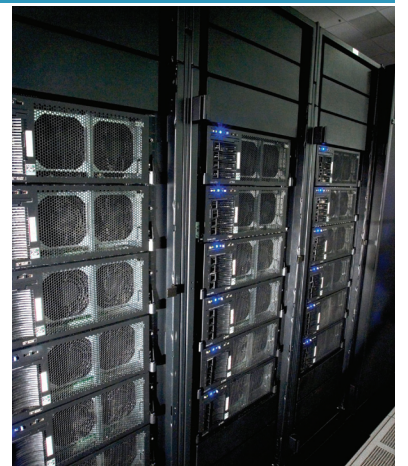

OGI App Development

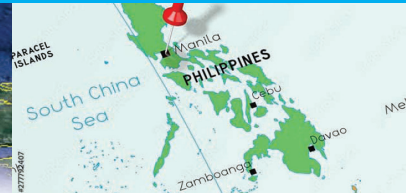

Southeast Asia Ministry Center



We plan to purchase land outside of Manila, Philippines, and initiate the design phase for an exciting and much-needed project. Additionally, the center will support educational initiatives and host multiple other facets of OGI's mission.

Crucial National Pastor Training In India Phase 4

"India Phase 4" is a 2-year vision to train an ORGANIZATIONAL LEADER for each of the 304 regions in India. This can be accomplished by training 38 leaders each quarter for the next two years. Our Operation Go Mission Center in Melur, Tamil Nadu will provide full lodging, meal preparation and training space for this event.

The next conference is set to take place during the first quarter of this year. Our ambitious objective is to host a minimum of four such impactful conferences annually until we have successfully equipped leaders in every region. The budget for each of these conferences typically amounts to approximately \$7500.00.
