

KENYA TRIP INFORMATION

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS: A deposit of \$300.00 per person is required to make a reservation. An additional payment of \$1300.00 per person is due April 15. The final payment is due by May 10, 2026. Payment can be made by personal check or money order. Credit card payments beyond the initial deposit will be accepted for an additional non-refundable fee of 3%. Reservations received after April 10, 2026 may incur additional charges due to supplier contract terms.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS: If a passenger cancels his/her tour membership there will be a cancellation fee of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) per person up until 150 days before departure. For cancellations from 150-91 days before departure the cancellation fee will be \$500.00 per person. Cancellations made between 90-61 days before departure will be subject to a 50% cancellation fee. There will be no refund for cancellations within 60 days of departure, no-shows, or partially completed tours. All cancellation requests must be addressed to Operation Go International, in writing.

TOUR ITINERARY SUBJECT TO CHANGE: OGI strives to adhere to our printed schedule; however, circumstances may necessitate changes without advance notice during the trip. OGI reserves the right to change the schedule of events, and we are not responsible for any changes caused by unforeseen circumstances beyond our control.

TRIP CANCELLATION: Operation Go International reserves the right to cancel or withdraw the trip at any time. In the event of a cancellation deemed necessary by the President of OGI, it is the sole and exclusive responsibility of OGI to refund all monies received.

NOT INCLUDED: Passport costs, visa fees (if any), and health documentation costs (when required). Extra food and beverages (including coffee and tea) not usually included with the lodging meals; optional sightseeing tours and excursions; accident and baggage insurance; transporting and handling excess luggage; tips to persons rendering special personal services; items of a purely personal nature such as laundry, telephone, room service orders, etc.

DISABILITIES: Due to the amount of walking at the sites we will visit, persons requiring oxygen or oxygen therapy will not be permitted on the mission trip. For reasons of passenger safety and well-being, persons with impaired mobility, vision, or mental capacity will not be permitted on the trip. OPERATION GO INTERNATIONAL reserves the right to refuse passage to anyone who is in such physical or mental condition as to be unfit for travel or who may require care and attention beyond which we are able to provide. The trip requires some mobility and we will visit places that are not accessible by wheelchair.

INSURANCE: Acting only as a host and guide, OPERATION GO INTERNATIONAL is not responsible for flight delays or missed connections, damage, loss, or theft of luggage and/or personal belongings, or for personal injury, accident, illness and/or death as a result of any occurrences or conditions beyond its control, including, but not limited to, defects in vehicles, breakdown in equipment, strikes, terrorist attacks, hostage situations, kidnappings, hijackings, protests, riots, public demonstrations, inclement weather, or theft. For your protection, **OGI highly recommends that you purchase travel insurance** to cover these possibilities.

PASSPORT: Each mission trip member is required to present a valid passport with an expiration date of December 15, 2026 or later. Complete instructions and application forms for passports can be obtained by contacting your local courthouse or post office. Your name on the Registration Form must match your name as it appears on your Passport.

DISCLAIMER: OPERATION GO INTERNATIONAL acts as a host and guide only for the trip. The suppliers providing transportation and sightseeing arrangements and hotel accommodations for the mission trip are independent contractors and are not agents or employees of OGI. All coupons,

receipts and tickets are issued subject to the terms and conditions specified by the suppliers. By utilizing the services of the suppliers, you agree that OGI shall not be liable for any accident, loss, injury, death, or damage of any kind to you or to those traveling with you. This includes, but is not limited to, conditions beyond its control, defects in vehicles, breakdown in equipment, strikes, terrorist attacks, hostage situations, kidnappings, hijackings, protests, riots, public demonstrations, theft, delay or cancellation of or changes in itinerary or schedules. Remember also that all travel documents as well as compliance with customs regulations are your responsibility. The terms under which you agree to take the mission trip cannot be changed or amended except in writing, signed by the President of OGI. Airlines concerned are not to be held responsible for any act, omission or event during the time you are not on board the aircraft.
