



"An Open Door"



May is a month of movement—schools wrap up, summer calendars fill, and doors begin opening for new seasons. In ministry, we see that same pattern: God opens doors for the Gospel, doors for training, doors for mercy, and doors for churches to be strengthened. The question is rarely whether doors exist—the question is whether we will walk through them with faith.

Operation Go International is seeing open doors on multiple fronts right now—from Latin America pastor training, to mission opportunities in Kenya, to mercy work among refugees near the Armenia–Iran border. Thank you for standing with us. Your prayers and support are helping us take faithful steps through doors God alone can open.

"The Open Door No Man Can Shut"

"Behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it..." — Revelation 3:8

There are moments when God gives you something priceless: an open door. Not an idea, not a wish, not a plan—but a real opportunity that only He could arrange. In Revelation 3:8, the Lord told the church at Philadelphia, "I have set before thee an open door." Notice who opened it—the Lord did. And notice who can close it—no man can.

That is deeply comforting. People can oppose. Governments can restrict. Circumstances can change. Needs can feel overwhelming. But when God opens a door for the Gospel, He is declaring that He intends to work—and He is able to sustain the opportunity far beyond our strength.

But there's also a gentle challenge in that verse. An open door is not the same as a walked-through door. God opens opportunities, and then He calls His people to respond with obedience—faithful steps, steady prayers, willing hearts, and sacrificial support. The Philadelphia believers were not praised because their situation was easy; they were commended because they kept God's Word and did not deny His name.

Dear partners, this is where you come in. When God opens doors in Peru, Nicaragua, Guatemala, Honduras, Belize, Kenya, Armenia, and beyond—your praying and giving is part of walking through the door. You may never stand at the border, preach in the institute, or hand the tract to the refugee—but the Lord knows you were part of the faithful response.

So this May, let's ask the Lord for two things:

- More open doors for the Gospel and training, and
- More faithful steps from all of us to go through them.

- Open doors for Gospel work and pastor training
- Protection for workers traveling into difficult regions
- Provision for upcoming conferences and mercy needs
- Fruit that Remains through follow-up and discipleship

Latin America: Open Doors for Training and Church Strengthening



PERÚ & NICARAGUA — God Is Strengthening Leaders in Latin America

Perú: Lima Institute (March 3–7, 2026)

In early March, Bro. James Adams returned to Lima, Perú for an OGI Institute hosted at Primera Iglesia Bautista del Salvador, pastored by Bro. Alejandro Barzola. The Lord gave a wonderful week of encouragement and training centered on “Spiritual Leadership.”

Attendance included 130 people—21 pastors, 5 missionaries, and 104 church leaders—representing 20 churches. Bro. Adams shared that many left the sessions grateful for fresh insight and practical help they can take home to strengthen their churches. We’re also thankful for Pastor Barzola and his church family, who continue to be strong partners—faithfully training soulwinners with the Operation GO method and helping other churches learn it as well.

Nicaragua: Managua Institute (March 20–21, 2026)

Later in the month, God opened a new door for our first OGI Institute in Managua, Nicaragua’s capital city. The institute was hosted by Iglesia Bautista Libertad, led by Pastor Denis Rios, during their church’s 32nd anniversary and Faith Promise Missions emphasis.

About 150 attended—24 pastors, 6 missionaries, and 120 leaders from 15 churches. The response was encouraging and forward-looking: those present set goals to train 1,504 new soulwinners and to plant 31 new churches over the next two years. Pastor Rios is planning to begin Operation GO training in his own church in May, and we’re excited about the potential for continued growth and partnership in Nicaragua.

More Praise from Perú

We also rejoice in another report from Villa del Salvador, Perú, where First Baptist Church held an evangelistic campaign at a local university. Twenty-five received Christ, and they are being followed up and disciplined. Even the counseling team—30 workers—were trained through Operation GO, which means your prayers and support are producing fruit that is multiplying beyond one event.

Middle East — Armenia Border Mercy & Open Doors

Bro. Wilkins’ May Trip: Refugees, Hope, and Gospel Access

In May, Bro. Wilkins (OGI Middle East Director) will travel to Armenia, focusing on ministry near the Armenia–Iran border, where thousands of refugees are coming through to avoid persecution and danger. OGI has translated a Gospel tract into Persian (Farsi) and—by faith—has printed thousands to place into the hands of Iranian people who are searching for hope.

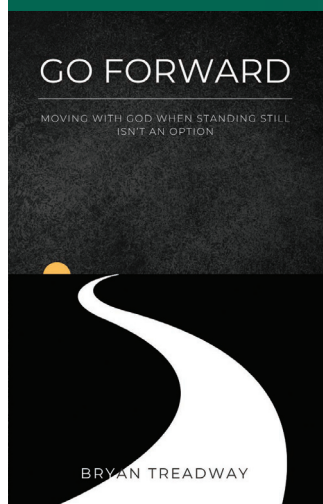
During this trip, he will also assess how our Middle East Mercy Project can assist refugees with practical needs such as clothing, shelter, food, and medical supplies. He will be looking for Iranian Christians and pastors to establish contact for expanded Gospel work reaching into Iran, and he will evaluate the possibility of holding an OGI Pastor Training Conference in Armenia’s capital—where Iranian, Armenian, and others from Azerbaijan and Georgia may be reached.

Please pray specifically for protection and safety, especially while near the border, and for God’s wisdom in every connection made. And please pray for national pastors, churches, and believers in Lebanon, where conditions have become increasingly dangerous and many areas are suffering severe damage and instability.
